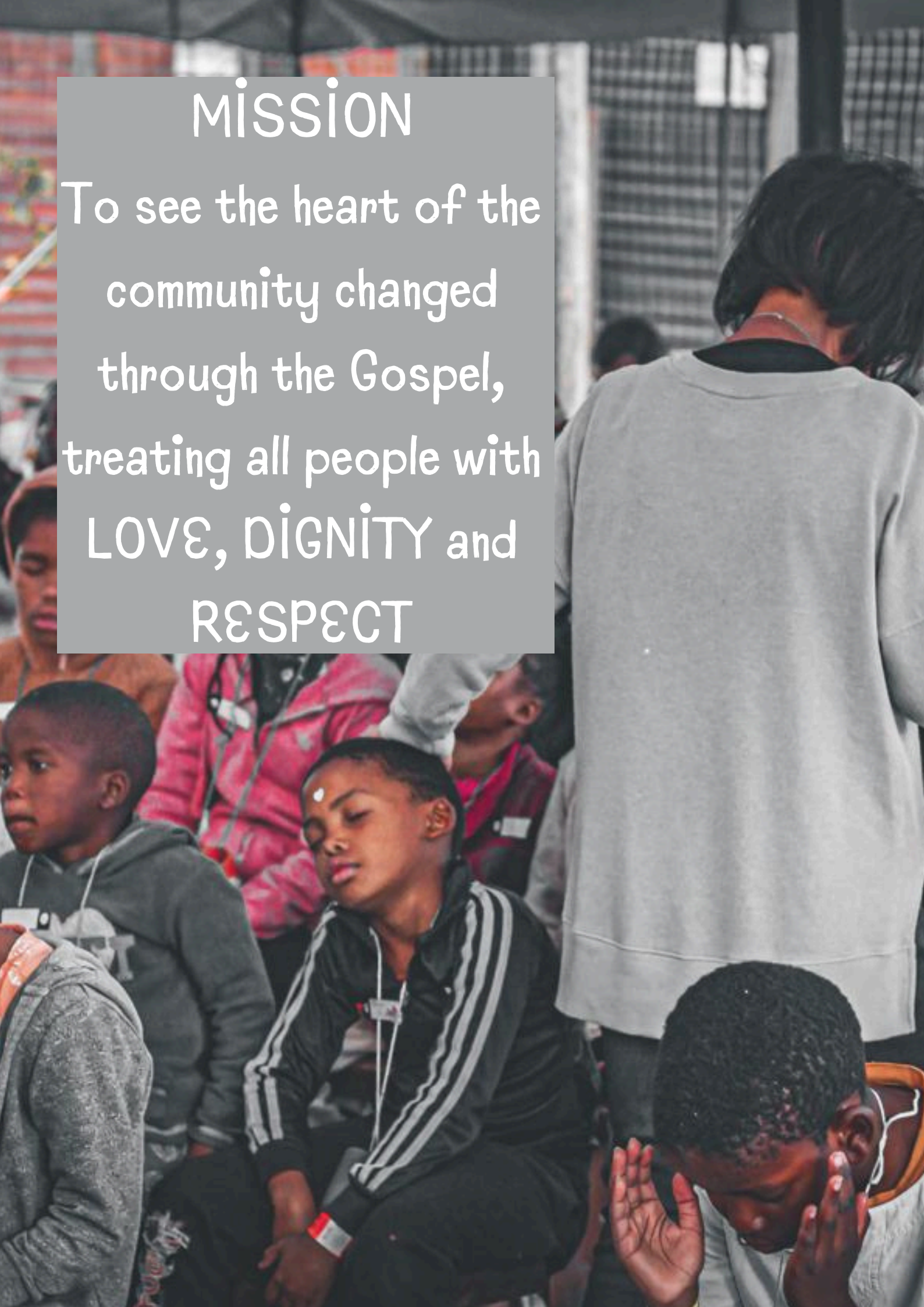

Our History

LIFE Community Services registered as an NPO in March of 2001 after Philip and Maryna DeVries came from the USA in January 2001 and established LIFE as an organization. The goal was to make a difference in the communities in and around George.

Together with volunteers from the community, 10 centres were established in different areas of George over a span of 7 years. The organization experienced a phenomenal growth and the Lord added to our numbers and programme development over the years. Annually, as policies changed in South Africa, our operational ways had to change accordingly and we could no longer have "informal centres" to operate from. Therefore, we are now striving to create permanent structures and foot prints for the ministry, which will enable us to reach the unreached children in our communities.

Over the years we have had a wealth of visitors, staff and volunteers who have deposited into the Kingdom through their service to the children at LIFE.

While he sometimes shows reluctance to work in his books, he is capable of completing tasks when prompted.

The assistant and I ensure he receives the support he needs to succeed.

Working with him has taught me patience and reinforced my commitment to helping every child reach their full potential.

02. LCA Assembly

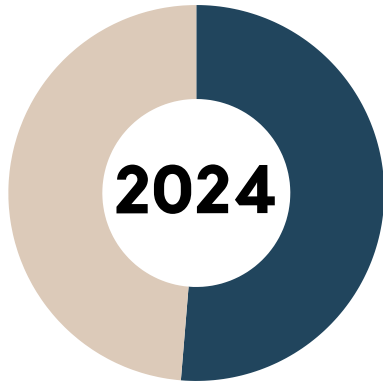

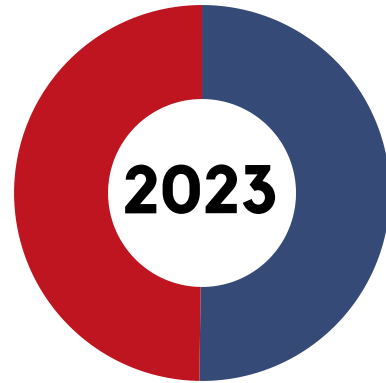

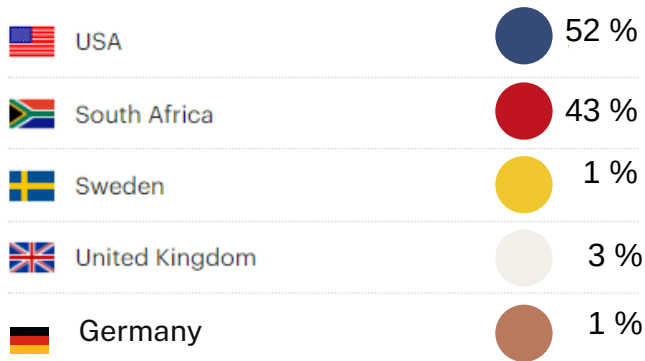




Expenditure

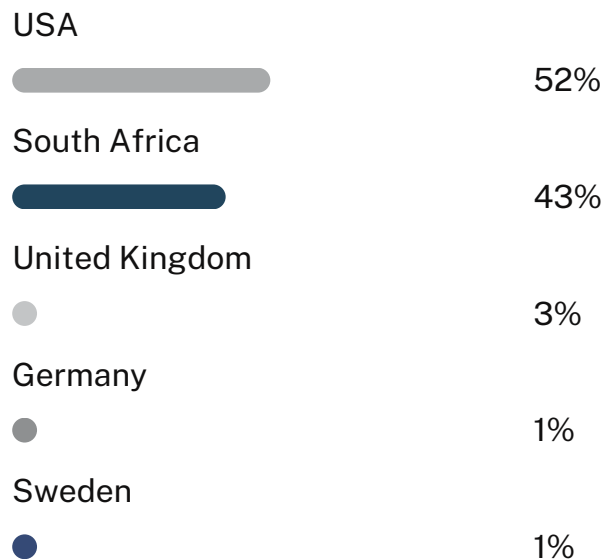
